<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● - An experienced worker is an invaluable asset to a company – everyone can benefit from their knowledge ● - It is only worth taking on an inexperienced employee if they are young and ready to learn 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● - Nepotism is not ethical, but it can be of extreme help, especially early on in your career ● - It is possible to get a lucrative offer from friends or family even before a job offer is publicly posted 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● - Creating a good first impression is crucial – especially if your qualifications or recommendations are not so brilliant ● - You might never see your boss again and that first impression can end up the only thing they associate you with 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● - A wise employer is more likely to show preference to prospective staff members that come highly recommended ● - Recommendations would also mean that the potential employee didn't burn the bridges at the previous place of work 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● - Similar to work experience, but with more academic focus, qualifications show person's ability and professional aptitude ● - Some companies might have strict policy regarding documental proof of one's education
